Summary

This classification performs security duties associated with the care and custody of inmates incarcerated within the Baker County Corrections Facility; assure clean safe and secure facility; admit, transport and control the movement of inmates; handle jail emergencies and unusual situations as they arise; maintain inmate classification system and appropriate recordkeeping.

Examples of Essential Job Duties:

- Control access to jail facilities; maintain key and equipment control; operate and monitor surveillance and electronic security equipment; conduct security and inmate welfare checks; conduct searches; control contraband/inmate property.
- Supervise inmates' movement; counsel inmates regarding their behavior in jail; supervise inmate program activities; maintain discipline; review and recommend classification and housing of inmates.
- Conduct inmate status checks; monitor inmates to ensure that health standards are maintained; maintain activity schedules; supervise meal services to ensure all inmates receive all scheduled meals; schedule inmates for medical, dental and mental health care.

Education, Experience and Training

Prefer experience as corrections officer and/or some college coursework in law enforcement OR satisfactory combination of education, experience and training. Within one year of employment, must possess basic certification issued by Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, LEADS certification, first aid/CPR certification. Must possess and maintain a valid Oregon driver license.
